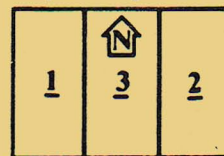


# PanzerBlitz Situation #23

MEETING ENGAGEMENT: DERBERCEN, HUNGARY (12/10/44). Occasionally during the desperate weeks of autumn, 1944, German panzer units found themselves able and willing to strike back at the Russian onslaught. Armeegruppe Woehler, reinforced by fresh units from Budapest, pocketed Cavalry-Mechanized Group "Pliyev" near Debrecen. The 6th Guards Tank Army struck back resulting in one of the wildest melees of the war.

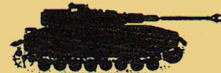
